

Dr Richard Bergeron

Scientist, Ottawa Health Research Institute and Professor, Department of Psychiatry and Department of Neuroscience, University of Ottawa

Dr. Richard Bergeron graduated from the University of Sherbrooke, Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences in 1986 and completed a specialization in Psychiatry at the University of Ottawa in 1990. As well, Dr. Bergeron attended McGill University where he obtained a doctorate degree (PhD) in Neuroscience (1996); his postdoctoral studies in Neuroscience were completed at Harvard University from 1997 to 2001.

Dr. Bergeron is a Scientist with the Ottawa Health Research Institute and is also affiliated with the University of Ottawa; he is a professor within the Department of Psychiatry and Department of Neuroscience. Dr. Bergeron is a clinician at the Pierre-Janet Psychiatric Hospital (Gatineau). His clinical interest is primarily in the treatment of mood disorders. Dr. Bergeron has had a number of scientific articles published in peer reviewed journals. Among other organizations, Dr. Bergeron's work is supported by the Canadian Institute of Health Research.
