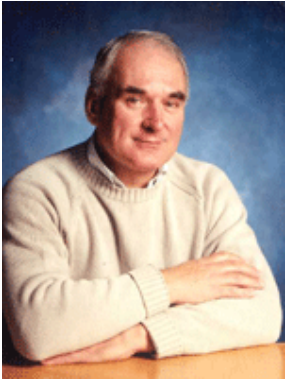


Dan Ondrack

Professor Dan Ondrack is currently the Academic Director of the Executive Development Programs (EDP) at the Rotman School of Management, and Program Director of several executive programs with EDP. He is also a former Associate Dean of the Rotman School, with responsibility for international relations and the PhD program. He has been a visiting professor at the European Institute for Advanced Studies in Management in Belgium; Groningen University in the Netherlands; the London Business School; INSEAD in France, ITESM in Mexico, the University of Hong Kong; Nankai University in China; Shanghai Jiaotong University and the University of International Business and Economics in Beijing, in China. He was appointed as a Fellow and Honorary professor of the European Institute for Advanced Studies in Management in 2004 and is co-chair of the annual European Strategic HRM Conference.

At the University of Toronto, he was also a member of the University Human Resources Policy Committee, the Appeals Board of the School of Graduate Studies, the Centre for Industrial Relations, and the International Relations Council for Woodsworth College. In the business community, he was a member of the Board and Vice-President of the Human Resources Professionals Association of Ontario and a director of professional education standards for the Association. He was appointed as a Fellow of the HRPAO in 1995 in recognition for his services. He is also a former member of the Board and Vice-President of the International Division of the Society for Human Resource Management (SHRM) in the U.S.A. He is now Chair of the Academic Advisory Committee for the Maclean's annual report on "Canada's 100 Top Employers", and also a similar survey in Cayman Islands.
