Elissa Golberg has been with the Department of Foreign Affairs and International Trade (DFAIT) since 1996, largely as an advisor and analyst on peace and conflict issues, human rights and humanitarian affairs.

Ms. Golberg was appointed Director General of the Stabilization and Reconstruction Task Force (START) in April 2009. Prior to this appointment, Ms. Golberg served as the Representative of Canada in Kandahar (February 2008 - 2009). Prior to this assignment, Ms. Golberg was the Executive Director of the Independent Panel on Canada's Future Role in Afghanistan.

Ms. Golberg has served as Senior Director and Deputy Head of START, Director of the Humanitarian Affairs and Disaster Response Division (2005-2007), and has worked as a Senior Policy Advisor in DFAIT's Human Rights and Human Security Divisions.

Ms. Golberg has participated in the management of Canadian Government responses to conflicts in Kosovo, Sierra Leone, Eritrea/Ethiopia, East Timor, Sudan, Afghanistan, Iraq, Haiti and Lebanon. She is a recipient of the Queen's Jubilee Medal for Public Service, 3 Ministers' Awards for Foreign Policy Experience, and the ISAF General Service medal.

Elissa Golberg has a Master's degree International Relations from the Norman Paterson School of International Affairs.
